

**Course-Related Fees**  
**England - Fall 2009 – revised Aug 7, 2009**

**PLEASE REVIEW AND GIVE TO YOUR PARENTS**

Students who register for any of the courses listed below will be charged a fee to cover special activities, such as study tours, which are an integral part of the course. Study tour fees reflect the cost of transportation, accommodations, some guest lectures and most site entry fees. Fees are billed from Syracuse following the overseas registration period, appearing on the Bursar statement mailed to the student's billing address in August or October 2009. These fees are not included in either the tuition or program fee charges, which are billed prior to departure. Any new course-related fees or fee increases approved after this date will be announced in a Course Update and mailed to participating students prior to departure.

All students who register for a course with a course-related fee are required to pay the fee, even if they are only auditing the course. **Financial Deadline to Withdraw from the Program:** Please refer to the SU ABROAD Study Abroad Handbook for information on refund of course-related fees for students who withdraw from the program voluntarily, involuntarily, or due to suspension or expulsion. **Financial Deadline for Course/Credit Changes:** Students in the program who make course/credit changes during the first three weeks of classes may request a refund of any unspent or uncommitted portion of the course fees. There is no refund of course fees to students in the program who make course/credit changes after the first three weeks of classes.

**Optional Field Study**

The amount of the fee will be announced in London. **N.B. The number of field trip participants may be limited.** If the number of students who wish to participate is greater than the limit, participants will be selected by lottery or some other fair means.
